

# **Serving the Community During the Pandemic**

As teachers across the Commonwealth shifted to non-traditional instruction (NTI) this March, Abound Credit Union was there to help with our VAULT program for elementary and middle school students and our mobile-first Achieve platform for college freshmen at Elizabethtown Technical & Community College (ECTC).

Both financial training programs, offered in partnership with Everfi, were able to ease the transition to 100% online instruction during the pandemic, supporting area students, parents and their teachers. In April 2020 alone, 300 students received financial training through NTI thanks to Abound's efforts.

In fact, the Credit Union's VAULT program has grown exponentially since last October, providing financial education to schools in six Kentucky counties and reaching 1,830 students. That represents a lot of progress being made and a bright future filled with smarter financial decision makers.


