Investing in our Military and Community is the strongest way to begin the New Year

Your credit union has always been committed to serving our military. This includes the broader community that supports them. We're proud to announce our expanding investments, in 2020, to make even more meaningful, long-lasting impacts on both our military and civilian communities.

We're investing \$1.5 million, through a ten-year commitment

You likely heard about the new, long-term financial partnership we've created with the Hardin Memorial Health Foundation. Your credit union is investing \$1.5 million to support military and community health. This ten-year financial commitment will expand services at HMH Medical Group Radcliff Family Medicine clinic, located near the Wilson Gate of Fort Knox.

Exploring the links between physical, mental, social and financial well-being

The expanded Radcliff clinic will be able to offer financial services and education, with everything housed in one clinic. This holistic approach to health will be critical in improving overall wellness within our community.

Research shows 81% of young adults and 64% of adults overall, identified money as a common stressor, according to the 2018 Stress in America survey published by the American Psychological Association. In Kentucky, financial literacy continues to be a key challenge with the state ranked 45th out of 50 states and the District of Columbia in WalletHub's 2019 survey. It makes sense for us to move forward with this partnership.

Empowering hard-working families across Kentucky

When ten veterans founded our credit union in 1950, their purpose was clear – to make a difference and improve the lives of fellow Kentuckians. Our mission remains the same today, we're here to help Kentuckians achieve more by providing affordable financial services and empowering consumers to make smarter decisions about their money.

Your credit union is leading the way in financial education with several key investments. Thanks to our financial sponsorship, high schools across the state will have free access to the resources needed to meet the new, state-mandated financial literacy requirement. Our VAULT program has already helped more than 800 elementary and middle school students, many of whom are from military families, improve their financial knowledge.

We're also continuing to lead the way in adult financial literacy with military-focused initiatives. This includes Military Saves Week and our Veterans 2 Entrepreneurs program, along with online resources and in-person assistance to help everyone do more with their money. When the new HMH Radcliff clinic opens in Spring 2020, your credit union will have a Budgeting Counselor on-site and host free financial education training events to help even more Kentuckians reduce financial stress.

Making more possible, together your support makes it all possible. As our credit union grows and gives back to more Kentuckians, we all succeed. Together, we can help hard-working Kentucky families achieve more.

2020 NOMINEES BOARD OF DIRECTORS




RICHARD L. ARDISSON
